A small group of residents has been meeting once a month to develop a structure for the plan and the sorts of areas that it needs to cover. We have settled on four key themes:

- Health and Wellbeing
- Built and natural environment
- Community
- Sustainability (planning/development/infrastructure etc)

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Don't be put off by the officious sounding names – this is about everything from sports facilities, health services, how the streets look, community policing through to how the village could (should?) expand.

We are working towards a large survey of all residents in the autumn but want to make sure that the questions we ask are relevant and meaningful. To that end, we are trying to encourage discussion amongst neighbours, formal and informal groups/societies, businesses and so on to inform the design and especially to identify topics/issues that we may not have thought of.

Could you lead or have a discussion and send us the results?

We will be organizing some events over the next few months but the best ideas can come from informal discussion and debate. To help, there are some prompts and resources on our website and in the library. This is not about policy or anything complex...there are no rules. Just take a few minutes to think about the village, our community, your group or interest and their needs over the next few years. What should we all be thinking about to help sustain the village as the place and community in which we have chosen to live and/or work?
